- 1. Meeting was called to order by Chair Bousley at 5:45 PM, present were members Bousley, Meintz, Deschane, Hitt, Lange, Langer, A. Mans, Mead, Meyer, Peterson, Policello, Woulf, Executive Director Hartnell and Peshtigo Times reporter Shirley Prudhomme. There was a quorum present.
- 2. Motion (Lange/Hitt) to approve agenda as amended; carried voice vote.
- 3. Motion (A. Mans/Langer) to accept the Secretary's minutes for the May 26, 2016 meeting as presented; carried voice vote.
- 4. Motion (Meintz/Mead) to accept the treasurer's report for the month of May 2016 as presented carried voice vote.

 - f. Motion (Peterson/Langer) to approve the Consent Resolution of the Board Of Directors as presented by ED Hartnell; carried voice vote.
